I continue to be impacted by the amount of Scripture that points us to Christ. The Word "look" has specifically been on my mind as of late.

Psalm 45:22 says, "Look to Me, and be saved, al you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other."

Numbers 21:8. "Then the LORD said to Moses, "Make a snake and mount it on a pole. When anyone who is bitten looks at it, he will live."

Hebrews 12:2 "...looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."

2 Corinthians 3:18, "We all, with unveiled faces, are looking as in a mirror at the glory of the Lord and are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory; this is from the Lord Who is the Spirit."

As Charles Spurgeon often said, "Look to Christ, not to self." Here is an excerpt of his:

Remember, therefore, it is not thy hold of Christ that saves thee—it is Christ;

it is not thy joy in Christ that saves thee—it is Christ;

it is not even faith in Christ, though that be the instrument—it is Christ's blood and merits;

therefore, look not so much to thy hand with which thou art grasping Christ, as to Christ;

look not to thy hope, but to Jesus, the source of thy hope;

look not to thy faith, but to Jesus, the author and finisher of thy faith.

We shall never find happiness by looking at our prayers, our doings, or our feelings;

it is what Jesus is, not what we are, that gives rest to the soul.

If we would at once overcome Satan and have peace with God, it must be by "looking unto Jesus."

Keep thine eye simply on Him; let his death, His sufferings, His merits, His glories, His intercession, be fresh upon thy mind;

when thou wakest in the morning look to Him; when thou liest down at night look to Him.

Oh! Let not thy hopes or fears come between thee and Jesus; follow hard after Him, and He will never fail thee.
